SETTING:

Worship is our first priority at Long's Chapel because worship honors God. What we experience in worship guides us in our everyday lives. But we recognize that distractions may be very easily accepted during a virtual worship experience. Maybe you have a child that wants to play, or perhaps you have lunch preparing already that you're also trying to keep an eye on, or perhaps the sound levels aren't quite right from your computer or TV. Whatever it may be, the first thing to do is recognize the distractions. Next, work on eliminating those distractions with plenty of time before the service begins. Before service prep your coffee, check your internet and sound, gather your family together and pray together, grab your Bibles and notebooks, turn off cell phones, and most importantly ready your hearts for what God has in store for you.

It is incredible how the simple act of trying to focus can completely change a worship experience. We yearn for authentic and profound experiences when worshiping God. Worship doesn't require the "right" worship leader, perfect light setting, impressive stage displays, or beautiful orchestration. It merely requires God and believers — adoring Him, loving Him, and focusing on Him.

KIDS AND WORSHIP:

Families, kids learn best when active. You may find that giving your child modeling dough, coloring sheets, or stickers helps with engagement.
