#### Presentation of the Protocol for Separation of the United Methodist Church

Sunday, March 29 at 3:00 pm in the Sanctuary. The Long's Chapel Church Leadership Team is aware of larger conversations that are happening in the United Methodist world related to an upcoming General Conference in May 2020 that will consider legislation for amicable separation within the United Methodist Church. We hope to host various conversations over the next few months that allow room for all voices reflected within our church and community to be shared. Some events will be educational and others will allow our church to find its place in this changing climate of Methodism while maintaining a strong focus on sharing good news with all of Haywood County and beyond. The leading legislation that is being considered in May is called, "Protocol" where 17 church leaders representing the broad diversity of the church agreed on a separation plan moving forward. Because of a personal connection in our church, Rev. Keith Boyette, who was one of the representatives in the room, will be here to speak to anyone interested. Childcare will be provided.
