

EXPLORINGGrow Groups

CHILDREN'S CHURCH - EPIC SUNDAYS

Sundays | 9:00 am, 10:10 am, 11:11 am

LCKids provides developmentally appropriate discipleship for children of all ages during all three worship hours on Sunday mornings. We explore the EPIC Teachings of the Bible with the enduring lessons of the Old and New Testaments. Kids build a foundation that guides them in living God's way. We dig into Scripture such as the Fruit of the Spirit, Armor of God, and Psalm 23. LCKids actively discover that the Bible matters and is a loving letter from a God who understands them.

During the 11:11 service, LCKids will be a time for children to be with one another learning more about choosing to follow Jesus. They will have a devotional time together and then deepen their faith with a video game platform known as The Aetherlight. (Pick up/drop off in Room 312 in the Children's Area.)

LCKids learn ways to worship God through song and dance. Our Jammin' Lamb leaders bring in the joy that comes from praising God in all that we do.

WE SERVE WEDNESDAYS

On Wednesday nights, LCKids use the foundational stories of the Bible to serve our community and our church. This midweek offering is quick but packed with power. Beru, the amazing Golden Pyrenees, is training to be a therapy dog. Our LCKids serve as her trainers each week as they guide her with on-the-job preparation so that she can one day work with kids in crisis. Along the way, our LCKids learn to read and tell the Bible stories in creative ways including music and drama. They also learn that spiritual disciplines, like obedience training, come from relationship with Christ, learning to recognize His voice, and living for God daily.

NURSERY




POVERTY IN APPALACHIA
